Located in the heart of UL Lafayette's main campus, Our Lady of Wisdom's new Catholic Student Center will deliver spatial components that reflect the many pathways that lead young people into a lasting relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church, including outreach, evangelization, discipleship, formation, and the sacraments.

More than 60 percent of students at UL identify as Catholic. Creating multiple opportunities to make them feel at home in the Catholic Student Center is a fundamental design objective. The more contemporary aesthetic design features a dynamic and energetic entrance that opens to several multifunctional spaces, including a large atrium assembly space and café. The layout allows for study, congregation, and events to occur before or after Mass as part of the daily college experience. The design creates a warm atmosphere where a first time visitor can be welcomed by peers to this magnet of student activity. A redesigned Jeanmard Hall, new commercial kitchen, and dining room will provide proper functionality for large retreats, nationally known theologians and authors, and sacramental receptions.





CHURCH SANCTUARY

The design footprint for the church follows a traditional cruciform layout with an entry vestibule leading to a sanctuary that will expand seating to 600. A key functionality is an alternate entry to allow students direct access to the sanctuary from within the student center. Other features include a more accessible adoration chapel, cry room, sacristy, bell tower, enlarged choir loft, and confessionals. Its Romanesque architectural form will distinguish and honor it as a prominent and iconic sacred space on campus.
